At TBP, our mission is to prepare your child for a lifetime of learning. We will help your child learn, grow, and have fun in a loving, safe, Christ-centered environment!

Our Program

TBP offers half-day programs for children ages two to four. Your child must reach the required age by September 1st of the current school year. Class sizes range between 10-15 children, with two teachers in the younger classes. Our small class sizes ensure that children receive individualized attention.

Classes are from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Our school year begins the second week of August and ends mid-May, closely following the CCBOE and Community Christian Academy's school year calendars.

TBP programs emphasize interactive learning in a colorful and exciting environment. Your preschooler will enjoy activities encouraging participation in every major area of age-appropriate learning—personal and social development, letter and number recognition, and motor skills development. Student activities and systematic review allow each child to develop at their own rate.



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Our programs teach your child as they participate in age-appropriate learning activities such as:

- Interactive circle time
- Center-based play
- Art
- Story Time
- Music
- Outdoor play
- Math, Phonics, Pre-Reading, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies, and Handwriting in the K4 classroom

Our Curriculum

Our curriculum is the Bible-based BJU Press early childhood program *Pathways for Preschoolers* and *Footsteps for Fours*. This program develops foundational knowledge and skills in Bible, math, social studies, science, handwriting, and language arts for future learning. This program, flexible for all types of learners at all stages of learning, develops the joy of learning through teacher-guided and independent discovery-based activities. Daily themed lessons with characters teach foundational skills supported by music and engaging visuals. Free play at intentional learning centers encourages natural curiosity, while group activities promote social-emotional development. Biblical worldview themes point students to a knowledge of God and His will.

Pathways for Preschool is a well-balanced program for K2 and K3. Preschoolers will have lots of fun as they meet with their animal friends daily at the Big Red Barn. Each activity and concept in the program is research-based and developmentally appropriate.

Footsteps for Fours presents an active, hands-on learning environment that includes individual activities, group activities, and suggested classroom centers for learning through play. Daily phonics, prereading, and math lessons explore foundational skills, while age-appropriate music, science, language arts, social studies, and handwriting segments give young learners opportunities to explore their world. This program offers flexibility for different types of learners at various stages of learning.
